Located in Sayama Hills, the stadium gives off an outdoor feel through its semi-open walls. Since 1979, it has been the home ground of the Seibu Lions, and in addition to watching baseball games, you can enjoy the different concerts and event held here.

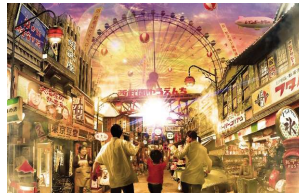
* Sayama Ski Slope

* Kurosuke's House

Kurosuke's House is a traditional village home more than 100 years old. Public interest incorporated foundation, "The Totoro Foundation" functions as the management base for forest conservation of the nature of Sayama Hills. In 2013, the main room, warehouse, and tea factory were registered as tangible cultural property. It is open to the public only on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays and you can enjoy the feel of a traditional farm house. When you visit, it would be greatly appreciated if you understand the purpose of the funds and help to contribute to repair and maintain the old house.

Sayama Hill Flora & Fauna Interaction Center was created as the central facility for the Ikimono Fureai-no-Sato. It aims for visitors to deepen their understanding of the nature found in Sayama Hills. In addition to an exhibition, lecture room, observation deck and other facilities, the center features an outdoor charcoal oven. Wildlife observation gatherings are also held regularly.

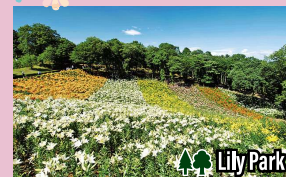

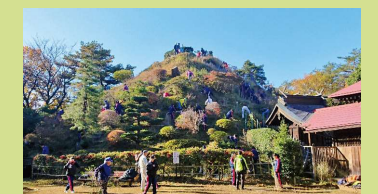
